The FUSP – Nida Centre for Advanced Research on Translation invites advanced graduate students to online gatherings with a hybrid format: via virtual access from anywhere in the world, students will participate in an ongoing dialogue with faculty who will gather in person. We welcome you to bring your innovative research and share your questions with our constantly expanding scholarly community!

Main components of the summer school's programme:

- faculty lectures and faculty papers
- individual tutorials
- plenary discussions
- informal conversations
- book/article presentations

The Summer School will provide participants with academic knowledge and advanced training throughout the week. During the Summer School, the associates will present their research.

Two weeks before the start of the Summer School, two additional meetings will be dedicated to the presentation of the program, the advisory board and the associates.

Requisites and application procedure

A maximum of 30 students will be accepted.

Applications are open to PhD students and researchers of translation in any discipline.

Applicants must apply through the **online application form**, which includes a submit a 300-word statement on current research and interest in the summer school, and provide a curriculum vitae.

Application deadline: 3 May 2024

The applications will be evaluated by the members of the FUSP Research Centre on Translation and all applicants will receive a notification by **8 May 2024**.

Fees

The fee for full online participation at the Summer School is € 400 by **15 May 2024**.

Your registration includes as well as admission to all events scheduled during the Summer School, personalized login to a virtual e-learning campus, access to the digital library created by the faculty, and additional digital content.

A limited number of bursaries are made available to cover the cost of the school partially/totally. If an applicant wishes to apply for a bursary, a written request outlining both merit and need must accompany their school application when submitted. Decisions about bursaries will be communicated to applicants at the same time as decisions regarding admission.

Candidates who complete the summer school will receive a Certificate of Attendance.
